Dear, Ms. Wood:

As promised, I am sending you a summary of Project Vote's conversations with Missouri voters regarding their experiences on Election Day. (Letter is enclosed.)

As you can see, there were a number of law violations that occurred with

respect to provisional ballots. Other examples of law violations are included in the letter as well. For the most part, it seems that the root of the problem is training/access to information. I am sure that the Secretary of State will be working to remedy these issues. Project Vote has some suggested solutions that I would like to discuss with you. For example, we propose that all poll workers be issued a "palm card" of frequently asked questions to which they can refer on Election Day. An example of such an information sheet is attached to this email.

If you are available, I request that we set a time to meet at your office on the morning of December 8, 2008. Does that day work for you?

I am entirely flexible on the time, as I will be flying in from Seattle

the day before to attend this meeting. If December 8 does not work, I am also available on December 9. Please let me know what day and time is most convenient for you.

Thank you so much for being so accessible and willing to discuss the voting process in Missouri. I look forward to meeting you.
